

Plum Area Youth Soccer Uniform Policy

The purpose of the policy outlined in this document is to ensure teams representing Plum Area Youth Soccer (PAYS) in area travel soccer leagues, PAYS sponsored tournaments, and in-house programs are outfitted appropriately.

Questions concerning this policy may be addressed to the PAYS Uniform Coordinator and Executive Board.

Travel Program Uniform Policy

1. All travel teams of PAYS must wear uniforms and accessories approved by the PAYS Board of Directors.
 - a. The PAYS Board of Directors will select a uniform which will be the standard uniform for ALL Travel Teams. No other uniforms or alterations to the approved uniform packages will be allowed. The Board of Directors may change/adjust the approved uniform package as it deems necessary.
 - b. Travel team uniforms shall be at the discretion of the Board of Directors and shall be colored utilizing the Club colors. Purple and White.
 - c. Any alternate jersey will be white and must be approved by the Uniform Coordinator in conjunction with the PAYS Board of Directors.
 - d. Travel team members will display the official PAYS crest on their uniform jerseys.
2. The Uniform Coordinator will be the single point of contact for ALL PAYS uniform issues.
 - a. Teams must purchase all uniform pieces through the Uniform Coordinator unless approved by the PAYS Executive Board.
 - b. All individual player purchases must also comply with this policy.
3. For safety reasons, it is recommended that no names (first or last or nicknames) are allowed on uniforms or warm ups unless agreed to by the legal guardians of ALL members of the team.
4. PAYS travel team uniforms will not advertise a commercial product or entity.
5. Failure to comply with this policy:
 - a. All reports of Uniform Policy violations will be forwarded to the Uniform Coordinator for investigation.
 - b. The Uniform Coordinator will report their findings to the Executive Board for resolution.
 - c. The PAYS Executive Board may impose penalties on teams that fail to comply up to and including suspension by the Club.

In-House Program Uniform Policy

1. The in-house and recreational soccer programs will utilize a purple and white reversible shirt selected by the PAYS Board of Directors and purple socks. White socks will also be used by participant in the U10 division. Black shorts are recommended, but are not mandatory. Participants can wear any appropriate athletic or soccer shorts (no buckles, snaps or zippers). PAYS will offer black Adidas shorts available for purchase. All head coaches in the in-house and recreational soccer programs will receive a coach's t-shirt for free.
